To a large extent, this was made feasible first by enterprise integration and then by open service oriented architectures (SOA). Currently, as services are built into ever larger applications, the coordination and composition of these services to achieve complex behaviours or to supply additional guarantees to the ones provided by the basic services pose several challenges. The main challenges arise from the complexity of many fault-tolerant solutions and also from the impact of service decomposition on the assumptions of the algorithms used in those solutions. Our approach to these challenges is to extend the existing Service Oriented Architecture with some services that will provide fault tolerance and reliability guarantees to the existing services in a transparent way.
