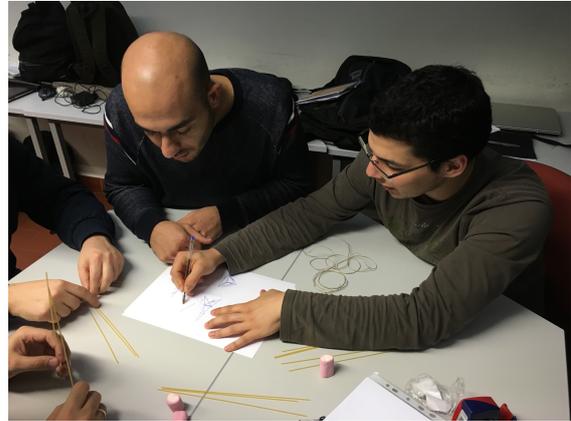


# Applying Innovation

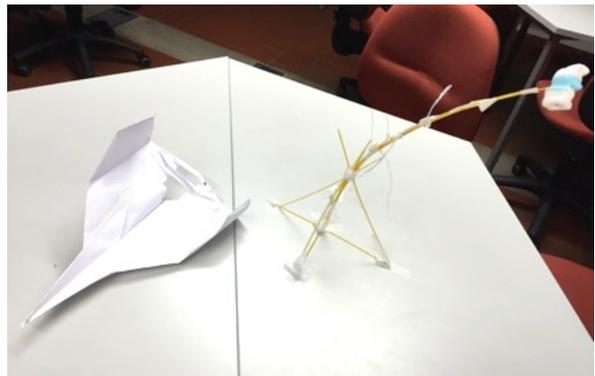
This course is about managing ideas. You will develop essential skills that can be applied within any organization. Skills will include: goal setting, customer requirements, problem solving, idea generation, project management, lean start-ups and leading teams. The course also includes a workshop on publishing your PhD research.
