LERNetALFA Contract - Project

Objectives

Implementation of a joint PhD programme on Software Design and Programming Language Engineering, building on a significant number of existing contacts between Latin-American and European Researchers. By stimulating a high level of interaction between Latin-American students and the European research community, the program will contribute to create expertise in a research area of very high strategic relevance.

The programme will have an undeniable **impact on the national academic systems**, and also, by **training highly competent professionals in software development**, **contribute to technology transfer toward industry**.

LERNet ALFA Contract - Budget/Actions

- Preparation and Support to Mobility
 - Prep. prior to mobility (linguistic pre-training, cultural sensitization, information, etc...)
 - 27 grantholders * 600 € = 16.200 € (Network contribution)
 - Need to justify with a declaration from the home institution
 - Welcome and Support to the grantholders
 - 27 grantholders * 1000€/grantholder = 27.000 €
 - 1000 € per grantholder (750 € EC contribution + 250 € Network)
 - Need to justify with a declaration from the host institution

LERNet ALFA Contract - Budget/Actions

- Coordination
 - Staff (Coordinator + Assistance) 4% total actions
 - No EC contribution
- Webpage creation and maintainence
 - 8000 € (EC contribution)
- Administrative Costs
 - 7% general total
- Other Eligible Costs
 - Auditing 9000 € (EC contribution)
 - Bank Charges forecast

Deadlines

- Selection Specific Criteria/Responsibility
 - Home Institution
 - Need to specify criteria
 - Marks
 - CV analysis
 - Interview
 - Language fluency
 - Eligibility criteria (nationality, enrolled at a PhD programme at home institution)
 - ...

- Grant Allocation/Selection Validation
 - Coordinator
 - Documents necessary
 - CV
 - Copy of passport
 - Individual PhD project workplan explicit reference to the mobility action and timeline
 - Institutional acceptance as a PhD student at the Home University
 - Letter by the LERNet local contact person
 - Letter by the co-supervisor at the host institution

Organisation of Mobility Mobility Preparation

- Forms/Documents
 - According to the specific procedure at each host institution...
- Formal Acceptance by Host Institution + issuing of compulsory documents
- Coordinator will issue a declaration certifying the grant allocation

Organisation of Mobility Mobility Preparation

- Accommodation; Language Courses; Welcome/Orientation Programmes
- Project Discussion/Formalisation of Joint Degrees
- Assessment
 - Period
 - Report (provided by the Network)
 - Questionnaire (provided by the Network)
 - Project
 - Report (assessed by the host Institution)
 - Issuing of the Transcript of Records by the host institution/supervisor

Organisation of Mobility Grant Alocation

Transfers

- 1st instalment 30% total grant + travel
 - declarations + copy travel tickets/original receipt + boarding cards
- 2nd and 3rd instalments— 30% total grant
 - declaration + intermediate reports
- 4th instalment 10% total grant
 - declaration + original tickets + boarding cards + final report + Quest.

Organisation of Mobility Grant Alocation

- Coordinating institution responsible for payment
- Transfer directly to the grantholder bank account (at host or home country)
