Project Objectives

Quoting the project proposal:

To contribute to the development of solid PhD Programmes
on Software Design and Programming Language
Engineering in the participating institutions, strengthening their respective academic systems

To establish and consolidate a <u>network</u> for post-graduate education, research and technology transfer

To create <u>expertise</u> in a strategic research area in Computer Science, in the participating Latin-American countries

The programme will have an undeniable impact on the national academic systems, and also, by training highly competent professionals in software development, contribute to technology transfer toward industry

To promote the implementation of joint academic degrees between LA and Eu institutions

To stimulate the <u>scientific cooperation</u> between institutions working on the same subject

Expected Results Include:

Publication of results of meetings and seminars;

Preparation of <u>Web pages</u> for the electronic dissemination of debates and documents;

Production of 27 PhD theses, in co-tutoring between European and Latin American universities, in the fields of software design and programming language engineering and their interplay (both at the theoretical and applied levels);

La - Eu Mobility: Profile A

Students beginning a PhD programme, who will work on research projects elaborated jointly between their home university and the European co-tutoring institution.

Will start their programmes of research at some moment in the first 18 months of the project's duration, and will spend the first 18 months at the European institution. These programmes may lead to the attainment of joint degrees.

La - Eu Mobility: Profile B

Students already working in a PhD programme at their home universities.

Will use the period spent in Europe to discuss, consolidate and disseminate their results, as well as to finish up their thesis work.

The Latin-American tutor will, together with the European partner, work out the scientific details of stay in Europe.
