


Location



- Policy of ECTS implementation since 1994/1995

The Future

 Set up a Region of Knowledge encompassing the whole Minho Region, strongly turned to the outside world

The Assets

- > 70% researchers in R&D Centres VGood or Excellent (Life Sciences, Materials, Electronics and Robotics) and world reputation in specific fields (eg., 1 outstanding group on masonry structures working abroad); the greatest number of coordinations of 6th EU FP: 1IP, 4 STREP's, 1 SSA, 1 NoE and is partner of 38 more EU projects;
- National leader of EU Netwoks coordinations with 3rd countries: Latin America (5 Networks) and Eastern European countries (Tempus and Comenius networks).

The Assets

- Large bandwidth (1Gbps) for internal communications between campi; upgrade to 10 GigaBit/s (end of 2004); external communications at 1GBps
- Virtual Campus by the end of 2004 (elearning 200 subjects already formatted, EASY LMS platform implemented in 2005, QWeb, all pertinent info available in the NET, Intranet, electronic circulation of documents, etc.); 350 access points spreaded throughout the 2 campi to build up the "University Without Walls"
- Digital Library with > 4500 magazines electronically accessible;
- Open Access and RepositoriUM since November 2003

The assets

- A program for certification of basic skills on Informatics encompassing 30 000 people in 2005 and 50 000 people till 2006.
- Number of PhD's increasing 8% yearly about 100% teaching staff with PhD by 2009.
- Close co-operation with the Municipalities of the Region (namely Braga and Guimarães)

The assets

- Networking with Industrial Associations (eg Associação Industrial do Minho) with partnership in one Technological Park and in 2 Incubators
- Two optical rings covering Braga and Guimarães by the end of 2005.
