Challenge

To prepare joint PhD plans for 22 LA » EU grantholders

- identify concrete project themes with a LA supervisor and a EU co-superviser
- itentify such supervisors and put them in contact to produce working plans along the next 2 months
- highlight the forseen mobility period, aims and sub-plan
- state the grantholder's post-mobility working conditions to ensure successeful completion of their thesis
- ensure the scientific coherence of the network



Solve the formal problem with institutions which cannot award PhD degrees

Proposal

- Re-allocate EAFIT/Santiago 8 grants to Montvideo (3), Minas Gerais (3) and San Luis (2)
- Agree on reserving a number of these grants for people indicated by EAFIT and Santiago
- Involve PhD staff from EAFIT and Santiago (?) in cosupervision in some way
- (Try to sort out the problem with ALFA ... asap)
